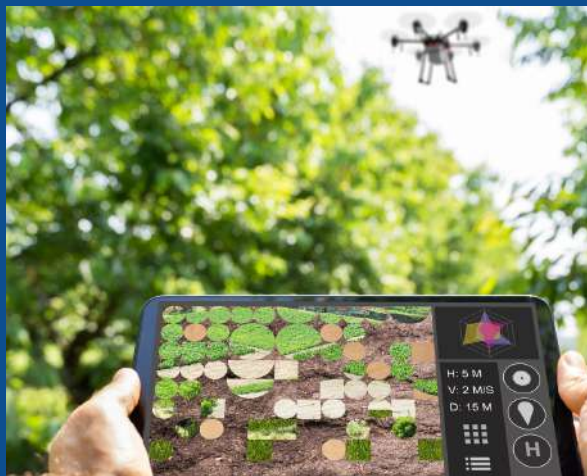

It was created in 1969 and is located on the Aula Dei Campus, one of the most prestigious agriculture and food research and technology complexes in the country. From this top-level scientific and technical hub, the Institute offers international training and promotes applied research and development in agriculture, livestock, fisheries, forestry, the environment, and natural resources in the Mediterranean.
